

Network Security Checklist

Router & Wi-Fi Security

■	Change default admin username and password
■	Enable WPA3 encryption (or WPA2 if WPA3 unavailable)
■	Use strong Wi-Fi password (12+ characters)
■	Disable WPS (Wi-Fi Protected Setup)
■	Change default network name (SSID)
■	Enable firewall on router
■	Disable remote management unless needed
■	Update router firmware regularly
■	Set up guest network for visitors

Computer Security

■	Install and update antivirus software
■	Enable automatic operating system updates
■	Use strong passwords for all user accounts
■	Enable two-factor authentication where possible
■	Install security updates for all software
■	Enable firewall on all computers
■	Disable file sharing unless needed
■	Use standard user accounts for daily activities
■	Encrypt sensitive data and drives

Email & Web Browsing Security

■	Be cautious with email attachments
■	Verify sender before clicking links
■	Use reputable email provider with spam filtering

■	Keep browser updated to latest version
■	Use ad-blocker and anti-tracking extensions
■	Avoid downloading software from unknown sources
■	Check for HTTPS on websites handling sensitive data
■	Log out of accounts when finished
■	Clear browser cache and cookies regularly
